Members-

Hole number 3 will remain closed for the time being including Best Ball. Dennis has formulated a new temporary par three hole utilizing the sod nursery area behind number 4 green. He has defined a hole of approximately 135 yards to be played from the right rough area on number 5 back to the sod farm green surface. Sequentially, it will be the fourth hole played on the front nine. It will be open for member play this morning and will remain in use until number 3 has completely healed.

Safety issues and right of way procedures will be defined so that everyone understands how this temporary change will impact play. Play will be directed from number 2 green to number 4 tee. Hole 3 will be marked as closed temporary.

I strongly endorse this decision. Dennis has finally in the past 2 weeks received the weather conditions necessary to grow bent grass in on number 3. Keeping this green closed will assure that all of the positive things that we have going on there will not be jeopardized by opening prematurely. Creation of this temporary hole will provide us with 18 playable holes and greens for member and tournament play. Tournament cards will reflect the playing order and yardages. Member play will require substitution of your score for the temporary hole to the number 3 spot on your card. Yardages will be laser measured and provided in the temporary teeing area. Drop areas and relief situations will be clearly defined as a local rule. Hats off to Dennis for coming up with a solution which is a win-win and ensures the long term health of hole number 3. Additionally, Dennis will establish contact with Forse Design to schedule a visit to address the root cause of our drainage issues on 3 green and a long range plan to permanently address the drainage in that area of the course.

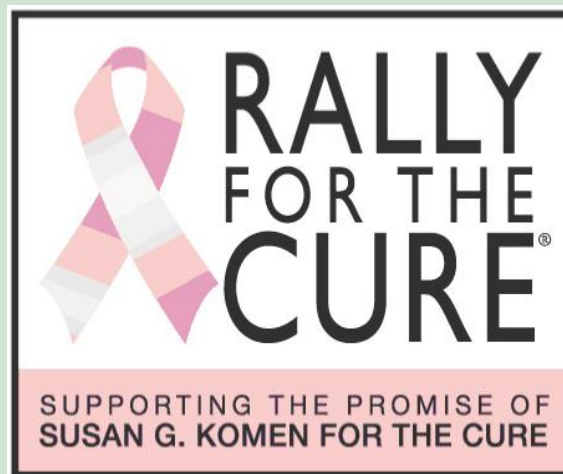
