Pool Rules for Patrons

The following rules are posted on the pool deck and exist to keep our patrons safe by anticipating emergencies and preventing them from happening. Lifeguards have the authority to make these rules stricter if they feel it is necessary.

- Pool use is prohibited when pool is closed and when no lifeguard is on duty
- Members may at any time invite visitors to use the pool facilities, upon payment of pool fees for each guest, provided the visitor is accompanied by or sponsored in writing by a member
- Pool members with houseguests or childcare providers may use the pool as members of the family after paying seven guest fees per individual
- Guest fees for the use of the pool will pay the applicable per day per person, charge only. No cash transactions, \$4 fee per guest
- All persons entering the pool must register
- All persons using the pool must shower with water immediately prior to entering the pool. This may not be taken at home
- No one may use the pool who has a contagious disease, fever, cold, cough, skin infection, open cut, wound, inflamed eyes, severe sunburn or is wearing a bandage or band-aid
- Special attention will be given to people with other physical deficiencies (i.e. weak heart) only if the lifeguard in attendance has been informed of the condition
- Nothing shall be taken into the pool enclosure which will tend to pollute the water, injure bathers or unduly inconvenience others
- Oily or greasy sun tan lotions are prohibited as they leave a film on the water that clogs the filtration system
- No one is permitted in the pool unless wearing proper bathing attire. The condition and type of bathing attire is subject to approval of the lifeguard
- Persons in bathing attire are permitted only in the immediate vicinity of the pool, and not on the terraces, porches, golf course, putting green, golf shop, or

- elsewhere on the Club premises. Exception: While going to or from locker rooms to private cars, while so engaged, bathers are required to wear a robe and sandals. Wet bathing attire may not be carried around the Clubhouse or grounds
- Children under 16 years of age are required to use the poolside locker and shower facilities rather than those in the Clubhouse and must provide their own towels
 - Although provisions have been made for the safety of the bathers, the Club assumes no responsibility for the safety of anyone using the pool facilities
 - a) A child shall not be permitted to use the wading pool unless a parent or guardian is in actual attendance
 - b) THE LIFEGUARD IS NOT CONSIDERED A “GUARDIAN” OR “BABYSITTER”
 - Personal valuables or other articles may not be left with the lifeguard for safekeeping
 - No food or beverage may be brought into the pool area from outside the Club grounds
 - The lifeguards on duty shall insist upon the swimming pool rules being observed and are permitted no discretion in the matter. Penalty for infraction of any rules will be cause for immediate suspension of swimming privileges for the entire family. The Board of Directors shall grant reinstatement of privileges
 - Prolonged underwater breath-holding or swimming is prohibited
 - Conduct that may endanger the welfare and/or comfort of other patrons is prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to, running, pushing, horseplay, chicken fights, wrestling, ball playing, unsafe jumping, and consuming or being under the influence of alcohol or other drugs
 - Non-swimmers **MUST** be accompanied by an adult in the pool at all times. The only acceptable flotation devices for non-swimmers are Type I and Type III PFD's
 - Food and Beverage are permitted exclusively in the picnic areas; absolutely not near the pool
 - Patrons may use pool equipment (i.e. kickboards, toys) and personal toys at the discretion of the lifeguard
 - Emergency equipment may only be used by trained aquatic staff
 - Diving is prohibited
