Enclosed please find your 2010 Application and Schedule of Events to the 67th Corning Country Club Men's Invitational Best Ball. This year's event will be conducted from June 3rd through June 6th. The Tournament will be limited to 96 two-man teams for match play competition. The event traditionally assembles a strong field and offers a premier golf and social event featuring four days of golf, incredible food, and quality prizes.

The Corning Country Club is proud of the tradition of this event and thanks you for your participation. Each year we look forward to welcoming you and providing our guests with quality playing conditions combined with an outstanding culinary and entertainment experience. CCC has booked Virgil Cain again for Friday evening by popular request.

The cart fee now includes the entire weekend. Each player in the field will receive one Professional Grade golf ball at registration. Wives and significant others attending the Friday dinner will receive a complimentary thank you gift from Bully Hill Vineyards. A discounted price is being offered to guests of participants making advance reservations for Friday evening's meal. If you missed Virgil Cain last year you missed an incredible evening. Six teams in each flight will receive pro shop prizes from a prize pool of over \$7000.

Tee times are assigned based upon the date of receipt of your entry form. All entries are date stamped upon receipt. Additionally the committee uses some consideration for travel time, etc. Please bear in mind that there are only 24 morning and 24 afternoon tee times. Some teams will not receive their requested AM or PM preference. The field of 96 teams and 4 alternate teams will be selected to participate in qualifying on Thursday based upon a points system. The tournament committee maintains the point list and points accrual rules. Alternate teams are eligible to participate in the Thursday skins game and attend the Thursday dinner. They will be charged only for their Thursday activities and the balance refunded. However, if a spot/s open in the tournament, and they choose now to fill the opening they will be charged the full fee for participating in the tournament. In summary, our goal is to provide each participant maximum value— inclusive of a quality golf and social venue and an outstanding and spirited match play competition. This has been the tradition of CCC Best Ball Invitational, and will remain so. We look forward to your participation.

Tournament Rules



1. Competition in all flights will be Best Ball Match Play.
2. Qualifying rounds are scheduled for Thursday, June 3rd. Tee times will be assigned and mailed to each team via postcards.
3. Contestants qualifying for the Championship flight and Medalist prize must qualify on Thursday, June 3rd. In the event of a tie for Medalist, a hole-by-hole match of cards from Handicap hole #1 back will occur until the tie is broken. Championship flight will consist of the lowest 16 Team qualifying scores. In a case of ties for the 16th place, a Sudden Death Shoot-Out will on the #18 Hole from a distance of 150 yards at the conclusion of play Thursday.
4. Contestants who are not interested in qualifying for either Championship flight or the Medalist prize may play their qualification round Sunday, May 30th thru Wednesday, June 2nd. Please contact Mike Heib at the Pro Shop for a starting time (607) 936-3392.
5. Winners of Flights 2,3,4,5, and 6 for 2009 will be moved into the higher flight for the 2010 tournament.
6. Six prizes will be given in each flight. In addition, there will be a Medalist prize for Thursday's qualifying round. Awards will be distributed at the conclusion of Sunday's matches.
7. Championship and 1st Flight matches play blue tees. All other flights play white tees.

ABOUT 40 YEARS AGO DUE TO THE POPULARITY OF THIS EVENT, ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND A POINTS SYSTEM WAS DEvised TO REWARD PAST PARTICIPATION IN THIS EVENT. THIS SYSTEM AWARDS EACH PLAYERS ONE POINT EACH FOR ENTERING AND PARTICIPATING IN THE TOURNAMENT AND ONE HALF POINT EACH FOR THOSE WHO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION WITH AN ENTRY FEE, THIS POINT FORMAT WILL CONTINUE.

WE CURRENTLY MAINTAIN A MAILING LIST OF ABOUT 300. IT IS IMPORTANT THAT YOU FILL IN COMPLETELY THE ADDRESS INFORMATION FOR BOTH PLAYERS ON THE ENTRY FORM. ADDITIONAL ENTRY FORMS MAY BE OBTAINED IN THE CCC BUSINESS OFFICE AND PRO SHOP OR BY E-MAIL FROM THE TOURNAMENT CHAIRPERSON (STEVE LOOMIS). sloomis@stny.rr.com

THE FOLLOWING RULES APPLY TO ALL APPLICATIONS:

- If an application is *not received* from an individual for three consecutive years his name will be removed from the mailing list and all accumulated points will be lost.
- Any changes made to the original application after May 30th of the Tournament year will result in forfeiture of play for that year.
- All applications must be **POSTMARKED or HAND DELIVERED** to the CCC Business Office to be date stamped **by April 15, 2010. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- Tournament points will not be awarded to a player who is accepted and invited, but does not play.
- Player participants will receive 1 point. Applicants with a paid entry but NOT playing will receive ½ point. Withdraws within two weeks of the Tournament dates will result in Tournament fee forfeiture. (Medical/ Family emergencies exempt.)
- ****Alternate teams who are invited to play on Thursday and choose not to fill an available open spot in the Tournament should one become available will forfeit their entire entry fee. **Only if the decision results in a reduced field.**

ALONG WITH THE ENTRY FEE SO THAT YOU MAY ACCUMULATE POINTS.**
