Golf Course Tidbits

For those of you that really enjoy a walk through nature, this is the most spectacular time of the year. Fall through early winter months brings out the beauty of architecture of this course. The morning, as the fog lies low and the sun pierces through bringing out spectacular sites. The early evening, the sun brings out the shadows of the rolling terrain. Producing spectacular images of the seventh hole looking up the hill and seeing the shadows from the deep grass bunkers is one of the best sites on the course. As you are ending your back nine coming down the seventeenth hole you move down the rolling fairway and look to your destination as the late afternoon shadow produce some of the most spectacular features of this whole course. Keep watch in the sky too – we have been watching a landmark of our great nation – the wonderful Bald Eagle with his wing span of four feet or so gliding over the course.

As for the conditioning of the course we have recouped very well from aerification. The fairways are bouncing back and our greens and tees have improved greatly this past year again.

The season brings on colder mornings with the results of frost and frozen leaf blades. We ask you to be patient on these mornings as this not only may set your golf plans back but realize this is an inconvenience for our staff too. We will do our best to get you out playing as soon as we can when this comes about.

Thank you for your cooperation on the course this year. Your support of fixing ball marks and filling divots on fairways this fall will greatly benefit everyone.
