The Tributes of the Golf Course

As the summer moves on and the heat and humidity build we will see some changes in your golf course. Mother Nature has been very kind to us thus far this year in providing adequate moisture when needed and many nice cool nights. These cool nights have not only been great for the grass to gather strength to get through the next day but for all of us as well trying to get some nightly rest as well.

Two areas' of interest that our staff needs an extra hand in is 1) ball marks or punches on greens and 2) divots in fairways.

1) Ball marks or punches on greens - please help yourself and all of your other members and guest in repairing the marks left by approach shots on the greens. We have placed many posters showing the proper way to repair the marks. REMEMBER if you see BROWN you should walk of with a Frown you have just turned the plants upside down! You should always see the leaf blades of the plants or the green side.

2) Divots in fairways should always be placed back then place divot sand on top and around the edges. This will help hold moisture for the plants to re-route. If there is not enough turf to place back in the area please fill area to top and step in.

The end of August brings time for Airification again. Please plan your golf accordingly.

- August 31st - Greens Airification
- September 8th & 9th - Fairway and Tee Airification
